

LAMINATE CLEANER



1. PRODUCT INFORMATION

The BerryAlloc laminate cleaner is a biodegradable cleaning product that leaves a pleasant odor and dries without leaving marks

2. USE OF PRODUCT

Use 50ml per 8-10L water and clean the floor with a well-wrung mop. Water remains must be cleaned up immediately. Laminate floors must never be damp or wet for a longer period, otherwise there is a chance that edges will swell and change shape. Avoid large puddles during cleaning. Do not use a steam cleaner!

Warning: the floor may feel slippier when it is wet (reduced slip resistance).

3. AREAS OF APPLICATION

Specially developed for laminate floors.

4. TECHNICAL DATA

5% anionic surfactants, non-ionic surfactants. Contains BENZISTHIAZOLINONE, METHYLISOTHIALZOLINONE, PERFUME, CITRAL, LIMONENE, LINALOOL, SOLVENTS.
